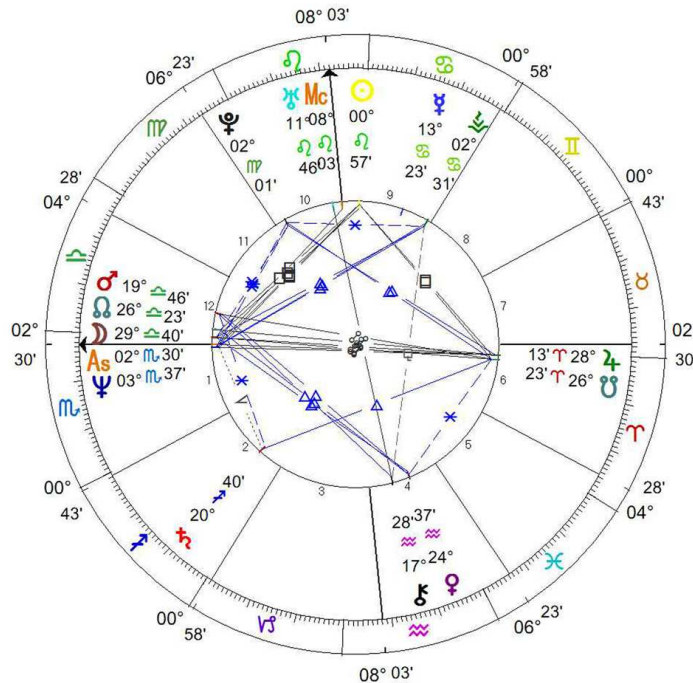

Definition of “Purpose”

“Purpose” is best delineated from the Composite chart specifically (rather than any form of synastry chart). Your Composite Chart is created between you as it implies *the evolutionary reasons for your coming together and progressing toward the fulfillment of that purpose*. These ‘reasons’ are beyond your personal karma and Identity-level goals for this life. Thus, “purpose” implies nothing less than how God/dess Desires to experience Him/Her/Itself *through* your relationship alchemy and growth. To be an effective vehicle for anything, one needs to be both transparent in some regards and fully embodied in others. It does no good if the pipes under the house are the best copper available if they have holes in them. Or if they too easily become clogged. It will prove pointless and perhaps painful if you fall into carrying stringent beliefs about yourself or the other, form a neat and tidy box out of neat and tidy reasons why you two should be together and how that should look. Being a vehicle demands Openness and the skill to notice the small mind's activities of categorizing and the ego's game of fear and sidestep them both, with gratitude. It also demands a *radical level of self-responsibility*. This means a tireless devotion to owning everything you are doing...this means *everything*. For example, self-responsibility in this sense equates with maintaining lots of humility from the fact that as much as you can dialogue together in the interests of 'working on your stuff' and intend to be open and honest about everything, there ARE things you ARE not telling the other because there are things you have not discovered about yourself just yet. And if or when these arise in the future, it will be a test of your humility and resiliency to face these things with lots of self-forgiveness and kindness.

Stability of emotions or one's psyche does not mean not breaking open or breaking down. It does not look like anything necessarily. Metaphorically, it is like each of you forming a healthy, communicative relationship with an ocean current which always changes, coming in and going out on its own invisible schedule. In this image, the only true stability for you is that of deep and wide *flexibility*. While it is true that you can rely on the current, that current is entirely unpredictable in light of things like storms, beach erosion, etc.

Being flexible *qualitatively* means developing an easy access to feel any of your emotions when they surface. And *quantitative* flexibility means allowing yourself to be taken on a very high or very low ride as often as it appears. Emotional stability boils down to placing yourself – small mind, ego self – firmly in the *passenger seat* when entering your private ship called My Emotional Flow. Over time you develop into the captain's seat but it's not a seat you can take before you are ready. The ego simply won't allow it.

Communicative honesty and depth for Judy is symbolized by her Mercury/AC, and for Bruce by his Moon. Judy is meant to really learn how to listen to another's opinion, another's reality and to speak to them in ways appropriate for them rather than how it might interest her to. This is all indicated by this important conjunction in Libra. With her SouthNode in Aquarius in the 4th House conjunct Saturn, the implication is that she can easily dish out opinions and conjecture as if they were truth, and usually most people wouldn't know the difference. This of course is a form of manipulation. The key thing to remember for Judy is that Mercury is conjunct HER Ascendant, not someone else, which in English means that she is learning how to cellularly change her mental assumptions from this type of behavior to one in which she authentically hears another person and can understand (Mercury) their position (Libra) *on their terms not her own*. Whenever a planet is conjunct the Ascendant, the function represented by that planet is one the person constantly returns to in many areas of their life because it is crucial part of their self-knowledge and experience.

Bruce's communicative honesty and depth comes from his emotional reality (Moon). So Bruce will need to watch that he not fly off the handle (his own Mercury in Aries square Uranus) nor allow his emotions du jour to dictate how he expresses himself, especially if they are negative emotions. Further, with his Moon in the sign of Sagittarius plus that it is the ruler of his SouthNode (suggesting that his Moon has karmic memory behind it), he should not give in to the temptation of convincing Judy of his position or opinion or, on a more subtle level, of assuming that she needs to be corrected, adjusted or expanded in what she's thinking. He should rather ask her if she wants another perspective and if not happily keep his mouth shut.
